Homeschooling

A situation still unimaginable a few weeks ago has become the new reality, and you parents have to juggle between Homeoffice and Homeschooling, between conferences and distance learning.

- Given this new situation, you should always bear in mind that parents are not supposed to replace the teaching staff. Their role is to support the children, to motivate them and to take an interest in what they have to do.
- Parents must understand what needs to be done, but they must let the children work alone, at their own pace, and above all not overwhelm them with extra material.
- If you have children of different ages, it can be motivating and stimulating for children to let them do their homework together in the same room, but sometimes it can also be counterproductive.
- In this case it is best to look for two or three different places where the children can work alone without being disturbed by their siblings. It is also important to set a routine, with fixed time slots for work and play.
