Learning - child's play!

Not all children like learning and homework, and not all children are always successful. Here are some tips and hints to make learning easier:

- Creating a pleasant atmosphere with few distractions is important for calm and concentrated work. Regularly scheduled homework periods leaves free time for play and leisure activities. While they are working, children also need short breaks and physical movement.
- Homework consolidates what has been learned at school. More difficult subjects can be reviewed and practised. Encourage your child gradually to do his/her homework independently. In this way, you strengthen their desire to learn and their self-esteem.
- A tidy desk or backpack optimizes organisation. Toys on the desk distract children from their homework. Tip: prepare the bag for school the day before with a checklist, and nothing will be forgotten!
- Every beginning is difficult! Be patient and praise your child, so his/her motivation will only be strengthened.
- School is not everything in a child's life. Achieving success through sports or extracurricular activities can only increase a child's self-esteem. If your child really doesn't understand the material or is clearly overwhelmed with homework, talk to the teacher and try to work out a solution together.
